

How to find the amount of classroom teacher funds that have been transferred for other purposes

1. Open DPI's Allotment Data web application: <http://apps.schools.nc.gov/ords/f?p=110:1:0::::>
2. Click on the tab titled "Year_to_date_Allocation"
3. On the left hand side, click "State Allocation - All Data; 14. By Allotment Type"
4. Underneath the magnifying glass, you need to filter the data:
 - Fiscal Year 2016-17
 - PRC 001
 - Allotment Type: ABC Transfer
5. This should show that four districts transferred \$1.1 million from the classroom teacher allotment in FY 16-17.
6. This figure must then be compared to the total amount of classroom teacher funding districts received in FY 16-17
7. Click on the blue tab for "State Initial Allotment"
8. On the left hand bar, click "7. All LEA"
9. In the yellow drop-down box, select FY 2016-17
10. Sort the data by LEA
11. If you navigate to the last row "rows 106 - 115 of 115" you'll see the statewide total for FY 15-16 of \$4,119,286,558
12. Divide \$1.1 million by \$4.1 billion to show that districts transferred out just 0.028% of their classroom teacher money in FY 2016-17
